Councillor Coyle Update	
Highways: Gas works in Streatley (and Whitchurch!) You will be aware that the temporary lights at the Bull	
Crossroads are still causing significant issues, although this was in part due to closure of Whitchurch high street	
as well last week (we did try and get Oxfordshire County Council to cancel this closure but to no avail) but that	
has now reopened.	
Hopefully this will all be over by 20 September 2024 when the gasworks are due to end.	
Repainting of lines on B4009: I believe this is due to take place on 19 September. At the same time as doing this, the Council are going to repaint the stop signs on the Aldworth Compton Road at its junction with the unnamed road to Hampstead Norries as a resident there had informed me these were very faded. Additionally, a new junction warning notice is to be installed on the approach to that junction from Compton as there isn't one currently.	
20mph zones: The Government released a statement last week making clear it would be for local authorities	
to decide whether to introduce these. It seems there is quite strong support locally for 20mph limits in the	
village. The position of the current WBC administration is that we are open to them if there is community	
support and I will be discussing with colleagues.
