- 4. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 29th October 2018. These were perused in some detail and alterations made regarding the Gully, and Westridge. The Clerk will re-type and alter accordingly. - 5. **MATTERS ARISING:** a) The Gully continues to flood, and WBC visited. There is a blockage, and remedial work has to be done.
 - b) The plot of land next to Whinwistles in the Glebe, does not belong to Yattendon Estates. Clerk to find details of the Housing Association, to ask them.
 - c) The drains in Ambury road are still overflowing and full. Clerk asked to chase WBC. Meanwhile Cllr Clark will try to help.
- 6. TREE PRESERVATION ORDER: the paperwork from WBC was examined and accepted. The tree is at Brackensfield, Aldworth.
- 7. ALDWORTH The Village History. Accepted and will be circulated.
- 8. PLANNING: 18/03227/HOUSE Westridge Barn, create a natural swimming pond in the garden in the north west corner of the plot. 'NO OBJECTION'.
- PROPOSED PURCHASE OF PROJECTOR AND SCREEN. This was discussed fully and it was All in Favour voted in, at an estimated cost of £2400. It will be

- installed as soon as possible in the Village Hall, and one day will be put aside for this. Cllr J Clark will arrange. It will be available for use for events in the village, as well as for Planning at Parish and Public Meetings.
- 10. FINANCE AND PRECEPT: Balance in the Bank £13,132.60. It was voted by all to leave the Precept at £7.5k for 2019/2020. Money is reserved for Elections in 2020. Cheques were drawn for A J Ives, use of home as office £36.46 and postage £18.08.
- 11. Meeting dates were fixed for this year and the hall would be booked if possible, with a notice going on the Board and on the Website. Clerk to action.
- 12. MATTERS FOR CONSIDERATION: There are a great many potholes in Westridge, and the clerk was able to advise that WBC has been given money to employ remedial work all over the area.
- 13. The next Meeting is scheduled for April 8th 2019 at 7.30 in the Village Hall.
